Alaska USA Wrestling (AUSA) is a nonprofit state organization that oversees all sanctioned clubs and numerous independent wrestlers across the state. AUSA as a state chapter is governed by the rules of USA Wrestling, the national governing body for the US Olympic Committee. Individual clubs host tournaments each weekend during the season which runs from February to early May. The culmination of the season is held in late April, early May when AUSA hosts a 3-day State Championship, holding 4 separate tournaments covering Folkstyle, Greco-Roman, Freestyle & Women's Freestyle
